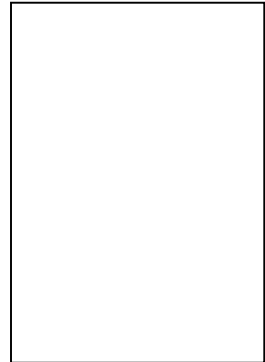

If you fail to file an answer with this Court, Judgment by Default will be taken against you for the relief demanded in the complaint. Your answer may be FILED IN WRITING OR GIVEN ORALLY TO THE JUDGE. IF YOU CHOOSE TO FILE YOUR ANSWER ORALLY, IT MUST BE IN OPEN COURT IN PERSON WITHIN THE (30) DAY PERIOD. NO TELEPHONE ANSWERS ARE PERMITTED. If you have witnesses, books, receipts, or other writings bearing on this claim, you should bring them with you on the scheduled date and time of your hearing. If you require a witness(s) to be summoned, see the Court at once for assistance. If you have any claim(s) against the Plaintiff, notify the Court immediately. If you admit the claim, but desire additional time to pay, you must appear in Court on the scheduled date and time of your hearing and state those circumstances to the Court. You may proceed in this matter with or without representation of counsel/attorney. The Court will schedule a hearing upon this claim at the Walton County Magistrate Court at a date and time to be set after your answer if filed with the Court.
